Information on Eligibility for Part 1 & 2 Teachers Trampoline Course and Refresher Course

To be eligible for the course candidates must be a minimum of 21 years of age at the start of the course, fit to participate, with the ability to perform basic trampoline skills.

Candidates must be one of the following:

1. Specialist trained PE teachers (this includes a specialist PE qualification gained abroad).
2. Trainee PE teachers who are undertaking the Schools Direct, SCITT or "Teach First" programme, or who are about to complete their PGCE course (i.e. in their final term). Students in either their third or fourth year of training to be PE teachers can also take the award.
3. Non PE specialists who are in possession of a current British Gymnastics Coach Award (Level 2) or higher in another discipline.
4. **Must have completed the 2 day Part 1 course for the Part 2.**

N.B. Support assistants are not eligible for this course but might be interested in the Proficiency Award Course for PE Teaching Assistants
