Information on Eligibility for Part 1 Teachers Trampoline Course

To be eligible for the course candidates must be a minimum of 21 years of age at the start of the course, fit to participate in the supporting of basic trampoline skills.

Candidates must be one of the following:

1. Teachers who hold QTS or a formal teaching qualification.
2. Trainee PE teachers who are undertaking the Schools Direct, SCITT or "Teach First" programme, or who are about to complete their PGCE course (i.e. in their final term). Students in either their third or fourth year of training to be PE teachers can also take the award.

All courses are tutored by a fully qualified British Gymnastics Tutor and delegates are reminded to make sure they bring their personal Dfes number (Teacher Reference number) with them on the day.

N.B. Support assistants are not eligible for this course but might be interested in the Proficiency Award Course for PE Teaching Assistants
